## EPHESOS – METROPOLIS OF ANTIQUITY

The city of Ephesos is located in today's western Türkiye and was continuously inhabited from the 7<sup>th</sup> millenium BC until the Middle Ages.

The Austrian Archaeological Institute of the Austrian Academy of Sciences has been researching the ancient site since 1895. The excavation is Austria's largest scientific endeavour abroad.

In 2015, Ephesos was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site. With almost 3 million visitors per year, the city is one of the most prominent archaeological sites in Türkiye.
